Hart 3 run rally in 6th falls short as West Ranch wins 4-3

Tyler Glasnow (Hart-2011) started for Hart and struck out the leadoff batter, then gave up a booming double to the Wildcats catcher, Dakota Hernandez that 1 hopped the right field wall.

Matt Blake singled up the middle scoring Hernandez.

Blake was caught stealing and Josh Heinz struck out, but just like that the Wildcats had a lead they would never relinquish.

Glasnow struck out 2 batters in the 2nd, and when he opened with a strikeout in the 3rd, he looked like money in the bank.

Then he got too fine with the # 9 batter Aaron Smirnoff and walked him. A bad pickoff throw to first and Smirnoff made it all the way to 3rd. With the leadoff batter Michael Alvarez up West Ranch messed something up, possibly a missed squeeze because Smirnoff was caught 1/2 way to the plate and Hart catcher Steve Rosso tossed to 3rd baseman Dallas Bacon and there was 2 down none on.

Then the game probably turned on the next 4 batters. Glasnow walked Alvarez, Hernandez singled to left, Matt Blake singled to left scoring Alvarez and Josh Heinz blooped a single just fair down the right field line and out of Daniel Dietz's reach, scoring Hernandez for the 2nd run of the inning, all after 2 out and the Cats had a 3-0 lead.

Meanwhile the Wildcats starting pitcher Ryan Keller put down the first 6 batters.

Kevin Bailey opened the 3rd and popped a double that no one could catch between the shortstop and left fielder.

Bailey was sacrificed to 3rd by Steve Rosso with 1 out, but Hart failed to take advantage as a strike out and an easy ground out to short foiled any scoring chance.

In the 4th a leadoff single by Garrett Gooding was wasted when the pinch runner was picked off first.

In the 5th another leadoff double this time by Luke Persico was followed by a walk to Baggio Saldivar but a double play and a strikeout again foiled any chance Hart had for scoring. Wow!! this was getting ridiculous.

In the top of the 6th for the Cats, Matt Blake led off with his 3rd straight hit, a long gap double to left center. Although Glasnow was able to induce a pop to short, J.C. Cloney then singled to left center easily scoring Blake. On that play the Hart outfield messed around with the ball and Cloney tried to go all the way from 1st to 3rd but the Hart fielders finally got him.

However the run was in and West Ranch seemed to have an insurmountable 4-0 lead.

It sure looked like it was in the bag for the Cats when the first 2 Hart batters grounded to second and struck out. Then Garrett Gooding beat out a grounder to second for a hit and Dallas Bacon slammed a gapper to left center to the 397 spot (where there used to be a marker), and cruised into 3rd with a triple scoring Gooding.

Alex Tenorio then slammed his 3rd homer of the season and just like that Hart had closed the gap to 4-3.

Luke Persico then bunted in front of the plate and beat it out, but a pop up to the catcher ended the rally but Hart was only 1 run down.

Glasnow took the mound in the 7th, walking his 4th batter of the game, but got 2 strikeouts, his 11th and 12th of the game.

Hart came to bat determined to make another late inning comeback.

With a 2 strike count on him Kevin Bailey was starting to swing but the ball was too much inside and he tried to both hold up and at the same time make a move to get his hands out of the way and the ball hit him, and the umpire made the signal to take his base.

But you knew there was going to be controversy on that play as West Ranch coach and Ex-Hart player Casey Burrill (Hart-1989) came out of the dugout to talk to the umpires and as expected they ruled Bailey had swung at the pitch.

The fact that the ball got away from the catcher was negated because the ball had hit Bailey making it a "dead ball". So it was just a matter of if Bailey was in the act of swinging or had held up.

Hart coach Jim Ozella went out to talk with the Umps but it was to no avail.

In retrospect I would have to say the umpires had it right despite the fact it was against Hart.

After a fly to right for the second out, Thomas Bilbo pinch hit for Gasper and singled to center, but the game ended on a strikeout, the 9th K for the Cats winning pitcher Ryan Keller.

Glasnow struck out 12 batters but took his second loss against 6 wins.

Hart will now have to go into the Wildcats den on Friday and try and salvage the rubber game of the 3 game series. Hart is expected to start Garrett Gooding, West Ranch will be going with their Ace, J.C Cloney.

On April 1, 2011 at West Ranch, Hart won the first game of the series 2-0 on a 3 hit shutout by Eric Vogel

Four runs and the offense is the story?

Yes.

West Ranch baseball's 4-3 victory over Hart at Hart High on Wednesday had a lot to do with the pitching of Ryan

Keller, but it also had a lot to do with the much-maligned Wildcats' offense.

In a game featuring two of the league's best pitchers, both possibilities for the 2011 Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft, not a lot was expected of the bats.

But West Ranch (13-9-1, 7-5) jumped on Hart's Tyler Glasnow early, and the 2-3 spots of the order would not relent against the 6-foot-7-inch right-hander.

No. 2 hitter Dakota Hernandez set the table all day, going 2-for-2 and reaching base in all three of his plate appearances. He also scored twice.

No. 3 hitter Matt Blake went 3-for-3 with two RBIs.

"Our team is as good as our hitting," Keller said. "If our hitting is doing well, our team will do well."

Keller was stellar for five innings before Hart jumped back into the game.

With West Ranch up 4-0 going into the bottom of the sixth, the Indians' offense came alive.

Keller, who was bending knees with his curve ball and overwhelming the Indians with his fastball, let up with two outs.

Garrett Gooding's simple infield single keyed a three-run rally.

Dallas Bacon tripled Gooding home to cut the lead to 4-1.

Then Alex Tenorio homered to the deepest part of Bud Murray Field, to left-center field, cutting the lead to 4-3.

Luke Persico then got on with a surprise bunt single.

Matters could have been made worse, but Baggio Saldivar swung at the first pitch he saw and fouled out.

Keller wasn't out of the woods.

In the seventh, he began the inning by hitting Kevin Bailey with a pitch, but Bailey was turning into the two-strike toss prior to it hitting him.

The home plate umpire originally awarded Bailey first base, but the field umpire overruled the call and said Bailey swung.

Hart head coach Jim Ozella said the call didn't affect the game.

Keller retired the next batter, but surrendered a single to pinch-hitter Tommy Bilbo.

The senior pitcher came back, though, to strike out Daniel Dietz to end the game.

Keller struck out eight batters and surrendered eight hits in the game.

But it all started with West Ranch's offense getting to Glasnow early.

Hernandez doubled with one out in the first inning and was driven home by Blake with a single.

The Hart senior gave up two more runs in the third, both on RBI singles from Blake and Josh Heinz.

West Ranch added a fourth run when J.C. Cloney knocked in Blake on a single in the fourth inning.

"Things were falling into place," Blake said. "We were able to get to his fastball."

Glasnow's fastball, which has been consistently in the high-80s this season, stayed around the mid-80s.

"Some days you're going to pitch and might not have your best stuff. But can you give your team a chance to win? He gave our team a chance to win," Ozella said of Glasnow.

Glasnow went the distance, striking out 12 batters and surrendering seven hits.

But the seven hits were much needed.

West Ranch is now 6-1 in games when it scores first.

Keller acknowledged that he got an extra boost from the early run.

Now, if the Wildcats can do it on a consistent basis, they could be trouble come playoff time.

They trail Hart (17-6, 8-4) by one game for second place in league and Wednesday's win all but assured them a spot in the postseason.
