#### HIGHLIGHTS of Game# 11-27: Hart 5, Los Alamitos 4 (CIF-SS D-1 Playoff G # 1)

Hart almost blows 5-0 lead, but wins 5-4: Bacon Homers, Tenorio scores 3 runs.

This game had 2 innings that were basically the ball game:

The Hart Bottom of the first and the top of the seventh for Los Alamitos:

After Hart starting pitcher Tyler Glasnow struck out the side in the top of the first, Hart batted in the bottom half. With 1 out, Garrett Gooding beat out a slow roller between the mound and first.

With Dallas Bacon up, the Los Alamitos starter Brandon Reynolds threw over to first several times to keep Gooding close.

It must be noted that Gooding was 0 for 1 in steals all year, but never the less he kept throwing over to first. Then after many throws to the first base bag Dallas Bacon slammed a tremendous drive over the left field wall and Hart led 2-0.

Alex Tenorio walked and took 2nd on an infield single to 3rd by Luke Persico.

Baggio Saldivar then hit a high chopper just behind 3rd and Alex Tenorio and the 3rd baseman collided. Everyone was safe and the bases were loaded but the Los Alamitos coach went out to argue the play trying to get Tenorio to be ruled out for interference.

There are 3 umpires at these playoff games and after much discussion between themselves and the Las Al coach the play stood.

Hart had the bases loaded. Kevin Bailey then launched a very deep fly to left near the wall, Tenorio scored on the sacrifice fly and it was deep enough that Persico and Saldivar were able to move up a base also. A fly to right ended the inning but Hart had a nice 3-0 lead.

Hart meanwhile picked up a single run in the 3rd. Alex Tenorio led off with a long hard double down the left field

That was it for the Griffins starting pitcher Reynolds who was replaced by a pitcher with more zip on the ball named Troy Rallings.

Luke Persico fouled off a bunt and with the infield playing shallow, Presico on a fake bunt, pulled the bat back hit a single past the close in second baseman scoring Tenorio.

In the 5th, Hart made it 5-0. With 1 out, Tenorio singled up the middle, took 2nd on a fielders choice grounder to 2nd and was wild pitched to 3rd. Baggio Saldivar then beat out a grounder to deep short scoring Alex Tenorio with his 3rd run of the game.

Then Austin Murillo one of 3 players brought up from the JV team for the playoffs, made his Hart varsity debut pinch running for Saldivar.

Glasnow had men on base in every inning, but it wasn't until the top of the 6th that he finally gave up a run. A lead off walk by Nick Vilter was followed by a 1 out hard single to left center by Mike Ferris sending Vilter to 3rd, where he scored on a sacrifice fly by pinch hitter Chris Colburn.

Glasnow then struck out the last batter in the 6th. It was his 99th strikeout of the year, but he had thrown a lot of pitches and looked done.

After Hart failed to score in the 6th, Garret Gooding took the mound for Hart in the 7th in a Non Save situation with a 5-1 lead to try and nail down the victory.

The first batter was Sam Lorenzini who was 2 for 2 both of the infield variety.

Lorenzini that slammed a hard line drive single to left.

Gooding got the # 9 hitter Pat Ivison to strike out but now he had to face the top of the order.

Leadoff batter Frank Padulo lined a sharp single to left sending Lorenzini to 2nd.

Moises Montes hit a wicked liner to center but Josh Brown was able to go back and haul it in for the 2nd out.

Nick Vinter then hit a hard shot directly at Dallas Bacon at 3rd, but he could not come up with the ball and the bases were loaded.

Lucas Hyman ran for Vilter.

Clean up hitter Dan Austin then hit a soft liner to right scoring Lorenzini making the score 5-2.

#5 batter Mike Farris then hit a weak grounder toward second for what looked like an easy game ending 3rd out, but senior second baseman Daniel Dietz muffed the ball and with the runners going, 2 runs scored, men were on 1st and 3rd, 2 out, runners on 1st and 3rd, score Hart 5-4, the tying run only 90 feet away.

The Griffins sent up a pinch hitter, the regular catcher named Andrew Yazdanbakhsh, who was injured but a .333 hitter. This was their last chance as Matt Millar the replacement catcher was due up and looked bad in his previous at bats. Garrett Gooding then struck Yaz out on 3 pitches and Hart had a very hard won and what turned out to be a very tense game.

They call him "Yaz" for obvious reasons.

Tyler Glasnow got the win and is now 8-2 with 99 strikeouts.

Paul Putignano was reporting on the game for The-Signal and for the Daily News, the Dodger beat reporter Jill Painter was there.

Here is a Copy-Paste of The-Signal article by Paul Putignano of the 5/20/2011 game against Los Alamitos.

The Hart baseball team doesn't want to change anything.

Heading into the postseason, the Indians aren't looking for a different approach at the plate or on the mound.

In the first round of the CIF-Southern Section Division I playoffs, they didn't need to.

Hart went ahead on Dallas Bacon's first-inning two-run home run, teammate Tyler Glasnow threw six strong innings, and the Indians held off Los Alamitos' late rally to win 5-4 on Friday at Hart High.

Up next, the Indians take on reigning CIF-SS Div. I champion Mater Dei of Santa Ana on Tuesday, which beat Temecula Valley 11-1 Friday. The site has yet to be determined.

"We've just got to keep competing and stay the same," said Glasnow. "Don't change anything up. I'm superstitious that way."

The 6-foot-7-inch right-handed pitcher only allowed one run on three hits with nine strikeouts and five walks.

He was relieved in the seventh with a 5-1 lead by Garrett Gooding.

That's when things got a little hairy.

Hart (21-6) committed two fielding errors in the inning, including one that loaded the bases with two outs and another that allowed the Griffins (12-14-1), which finished second in the Sunset League, to pull within one run.

Los Alamitos designated hitter Dan Austin hit an RBI single with the bases loaded in the final frame that made the score 5-2. Then, Michael Ferris' grounder to second was bobbled and rolled into the outfield, plating two more.

But Gooding struck out pinch hitter Andrew Yazdanbakhsh with the tying run on third to end the game.

"We've talked about that in the playoffs, it's all about advancing. You've got to play well. We played well until the seventh," said Indians head coach Jim Ozella. "This is a group that just loves to play and loves to get after it, and we got after it today. They are loose. I don't think there is anything to be nervous about, because no one expected us to be here. Might as well have the time of your life."

The Indians were loose early on, especially after Bacon's home run in the first inning.

Los Alamitos starting pitcher Brandon Reynolds, who entered the game with a 1.84 ERA, hung a change-up over the plate and the Hart third baseman sent the ball over the wall in left field with Gooding on first.

"Usually when we get the lead early, we win," Bacon said. "It gave us some confidence early."

Hart's Baggio Saldivar singled later in the inning and teammate Alex Tenorio collided with Griffin third baseman Mick Schroeder, who was attempting to field the ball. Tenorio was called safe and eventually scored on Kevin Bailey's sacrifice fly to left for a 3-0 lead.

Los Alamitos head coach Aaron Moore argued that Tenorio should have been out for obstructing the play.

"Boy, we were really set behind the eight-ball on some questionable calls," Moore said. "I'm really proud of the kids to battle back from big adversity."

Hart added to the adversity in the third when shortstop Luke Persico showed bunt, pulled back and hit an RBI single up the middle for a 4-0 lead.

Then in the fifth, Saldivar added an RBI single that put the Indians ahead 5-0.

The Griffins' first run of the game came on an RBI sacrifice fly to deep left-center field by pinch hitter Christian Colburn.

Sam Lorenzini finished 3-for-3 for Los Alamitos. Reynolds took the loss, allowing four earned runs on six hits, one walk and one strikeout over two innings. Troy Rallings took over in the third and pitched the rest of the way. Rallings struck out five and gave up one run on three hits.

Tenorio was 2-for-2 with a walk, a double and three runs scored, while Persico and Saldivar both wound up 2-for-3.

"(We've got to) play one game at a time," Bacon said. "We knew we had to win this one. We all were pumped up to keep going in the playoffs."
