Believe it or not, Hart was actually in this game for the first 3 innings with a 2-1 lead.

Garrett Gooding started for Hart got a line out and a strikeout but then walked Ty Moore who was hitting .521 going into this game.

Sophomore catcher Jeremy Martinez then hit a long fly to right that almost carried out of the ball park, hitting the wall for a double, scoring Moore from first. After walking Ryan Teel, Gooding ended the inning with a strikeout and the Monarchs had only 1 run.

As I expected Mater Dei started their # 2 pitcher Davis Tominaga and he immediately walked Daniel Dietz. Dietz took second on a fielders choice grounder by Garrett Gooding and 3rd on a short fly to right by Dallas Bacon. With Alex Tenorio up Tominaga committed a balk scoring Dietz to tie it 1-1. Tominaga might have become un-nerved by the balk and immediately walked Alex Tenorio and Luke Persico. Baggio Saldivar then singled up the middle scoring Tenorio and Hart led 2-1.

Gooding settled down for the next 2 innings giving up only a single and a walk.

Meanwhile Hart got 2 hits in the 2nd by Steve Rosso and Daniel Dietz but left them stranded.

In the 3rd, Alex Tenorio was hit by pitch and stole 2nd.

After a strikeout Baggio Saldivar hit a ball in the 5-6 hole that was headed for left field and a sure run, but the Monarchs shortstop Blake Thomsen mad a great stop and almost caught Tenorio rounding 3rd. Saldivar was safe at first with his second hit.

Mater Dei started warming up their # 3 pitcher, but Tominaga got Bailey trying to squeeze and Saldivar took second on the sacrifice, but Tenorio had to hold at 3rd.

When the inning ended with a strike out and no runs, Hart had left 6 men on in 3 innings and still led 2-1.

But disaster fell on Hart in the 4th as Mater Dei scored 4 unearned runs.

Gooding struck out the first batter Ryan McMahon but Tominaga reached on an error at short.

After a single by Miguel Sandoval, a Single by Ryan Barr to right scored a run and a second run scored when the relay throw got past 3rd for another error. After a pop up for the 2nd out which would have retired the side was followed by a walk to Blake Thomason.

The Monarchs big sticker Ty Moore then unloaded a long double to the deepest part of left field scoring 2 more. Moore was out trying to stretch his hit to a triple, but 4 unearned runs were in, and Mater Dei led 5-2.

With the 3 run lead Tominaga took the mound in the bottom of the 4th, and looked like a different pitcher.

In the next 4 innings he got 12 of the 13 batters he faced only walking Kevin Bailey in the bottom of the 6th.

From the 2nd thru the 7th he struck out 10 men and 5 of them went down with the bat on their shoulders.

In the top of the 6th, Gooding got a come backer and a strikeout for 2 quick outs but the next 2 batters hit the ball hard and Gooding was done.

Coach Jim Ozella brought in Tyler Glasnow to pitch to Blake Thomsen who promptly unloaded a long double scoring 2 more runs to make it 7-2. Glasnow intentionally walked Ty Moore and finally ended the inning with a fly to right.

In the top of the 9th, Bobby Stafford relieved and got 2 quick outs but then walked 2 batters and gave up 2 line drive singles for 2 more runs, making it 9-2.

Hart then brought in Ricky Torres who has been stellar all season but Blake Thomsen greeted him with a 3 run homer to get the final score up to 12-2.

Thomsen was the hitting star for Mater Dei with a 2 run double and a 3 run homer for 5 RBI.

Hart ends up the season at 21-7. Mater Dei is now 24-5 and will face Esperanza which beat Newbury Park 20-9 Valencia lost 8-6 to Dana Hills. Dana Hills beat Valencia a couple of weeks ago in a double header at USC. So all the Foothill League teams are now eliminated.

Since the Foothill League was promoted to Division 1 in 2005 none of the teams have fared well or gone far in the D-1 Playoffs.

Long story short, Mater Dei is a very good team and came in with stellar hitting Stats and 2 terrific Pitchers and a 3rd with a 4-0 record who was warming up in the 2nd & 3rd but was not needed after the 3rd.

The Sophomore Catcher Jeremy Martinez has caught every game this season and I looked up his stats for last year as a Freshman and he played in all 30 games and hit .348 with 3 homers. So this kid has 2 more years after this and he

almost hit a homer in the first inning against Hart today when he doubled.

Here's what I wrote in the last newsletter.

I'm thinking we will see Tominaga.

A 12-2 Hart baseball loss in the second round of the CIF-Southern Section Division I playoffs to Mater Dei at Hart High on Tuesday could have been different.

A whole lot different.

Maybe even a win.

"Things could have been different," said Hart starting pitcher Garrett Gooding. "That's what happens in baseball. You don't always get the breaks."

Gooding was in the middle of making the defending Division I champions and current No. 2 seed look beatable.

In the fourth inning, everything changed.

With one out in the inning and Hart (21-7) up 2-1, Gooding induced a hard-hit, yet very playable ground ball to shortstop from Mater Dei's Davis Tominaga.

It seemed as if Gooding was going to have two quick outs.

But shortstop Luke Persico mishandled the ball, allowing Tominaga to reach base safely.

After a Miguel Sandoval single, Monarch Ryan Barr singled to right field, allowing Tominaga to score and tie the game at 2-2.

Indians second baseman Daniel Dietz took the cut-off through and threw it over the head of third baseman Dallas Bacon, allowing Sandoval to score, giving Mater Dei a 3-2 lead.

Three batters later, Mater Dei's Ty Moore doubled in two more runs.

"We were in it. The wheels kind of fell off the bus a little bit," said Hart head coach Jim Ozella. "We really thought we had the right guy on the mound. We were doing things the right way. Obviously the fourth inning haunted us."

So will the first, second and third innings.

Gooding got two quick outs to start the game, but then he walked a batter and allowed a run-scoring double to Jeremy Martinez, allowing the Monarchs (23-6) to take a 1-0 lead.

Hart came back with two in their half of the first inning, thanks to Tominaga balking in a run and allowing Baggio Saldivar to knock in a run with a single. Saldivar was 2-for-3 in the game.

But Hart's Kevin Bailey, with two on, swung at the first pitch he saw and fouled out, stranding two runners.

Hart stranded two more in the second and two more in the third.

That was their opening off Tominaga.

Tominaga got comfortable on the mound, saying he wasn't used to the steep fall from the rubber early on.

He then began to throw more change-ups than fastballs.

Gooding, who batted second in the lineup, said Tominaga got him out twice on change-ups.

Then Mater Dei's bats pounced on Hart's mistakes.

"I can always trust them to put on a show," Tominaga said of his offense. "When they hit, it's fun to watch."

Following the four-run fourth, the Monarchs scored twice more in the sixth and five times in the seventh.

In the sixth and seventh, Blake Thomsen delivered the punch.

He had a two-RBI double in the sixth and a three-run home run in the seventh.

"It was really big for us," said Thomsen of Mater Dei's ability to capitalize on Hart's mistakes. "We had to make them pay. We knew they were a great team and they weren't going to make a lot of mistakes."

Yet Hart made too many.

Gooding, despite the outcome, did pitch well, going 5 2/3 innings, allowing seven hits, striking out seven and allowing seven runs. Only four of those runs were earned and two others were tacked on to his line after Tyler Glasnow gave up the double to Thomsen with Gooding's runners on base.

Hart made a run at the Foothill League title in 2011, one season removed from a battle just to get into the postseason.

They leave 2011 wondering if they could have made a deeper run into the postseason.
