On 4/10/99 Hart beat Cypress 9-5. What was unusual about this game? Hart used only 9 players the entire game. Justin Wiley and Jamie Shields pitched and swapped positions at 1st base. A check of the records finds this has happened only 1 other time since 1987.
On 4/19/88, Hart (at home) beat Alhambra 3-0, with Robby Davis going all the way, The game was called after 5 innings due to rain.
Most Players used in a game was 21 on 4/29/97 vs Canyon, in a game won by Hart 13-0.
NOTE * 1997 had a large player roster ( 23 players), thus accounting for 4 other games where 20 players were used...
LARGEST PLAYER ROSTER IN A SEASON was 2007 which had 25 Players on the Roster.

Hart set 3 records in a 29-0 game against Golden Valley on 4/4/08. AB's 50, Runs, 29, Hits 25 and tied RBI record of 25. Most of the Hart Team and Individual game records tend to be against Burbank, mainly because we play them a lot but mostly because they have a ball park that's condusive to high scores and they haven't had very good teams down through the years. Not suprisingly Hart has performad the feat 15 times and 5 of those games were against Burbank.
Hart had 23 Hits against Canyon in 1987 in a $27-2$ rout, scoring 14 runs in the 4 th. This was when Canyon was in the Golden League. Of the 5 times recording over 20 Hits against Burbank only the 1999 game was played at Hart when they romped 19-1.
The game against La Salle in 1989 was in the first round of the playoffs with Hart winning 23-4, when Ray Gardocki hit for the cycle. Here is the list of $\mathbf{1 4}$ games where Hart got $\mathbf{2 0}$ or more hits in a game.

The 3 sacrifice flys against Golden Valley on 4/2/2008 tied a team record set 8 times previously. Thats the 2nd time for 3 sac flies in 2008 Hart had a chance for a 4th in that game but got a popup to short. The 1998 game against Valencia was a 13-11 thriller wi $\mathbf{n}$ for Hart. 3 sac flies were first recorded in 1988 against Las Vegas Nevada in a Easter tourney in Vagas.
Again in 1988 against Arroyo Grande in a 18-3 playoff game that gave Hart a record of 26-0 at that time.
(They lost their next game 12-7 and were eliminated by Fullerton).
They got 3 more against El Segundo in 1989 in a 12-11 game were they scored 5 runs in the bottom of the 7 th to pull it out.
(They went to the Final game at Dodger Stadium that year losing to Cerritos 4-1).
In 1994 in the opening playoff round they did it again against Culver City winning 12-2.
They got to the quarter finals that year but lost at Rio Mesa 1-0 on a "sac fly" in the bottom of the 9th inning.
(Live by the sword, die by the sword).


On 4/4/08 in a regulation 7 inning game Hart had 50 at Bats against Golden Valley in a 29-0 rout at Golden Valley. On 4/12/02 in a 10 inning game against Valencia Hart batters had 45 at bats. This broke the previous record of 44 also against Valencia on 4/30/96 in a regular 7 inning game where Hart scored 24 runs.
