In the 4/22/09 game against Valencia, Hart took a commanding 8-0 lead with 7 runs in the 2nd on a Grand Slam by Pat Valaika and 3 run shot by Devin Rodriguez, but Hart pitcher Trevor Brown got wild in the 3rd as the Vikings closed to 8-3. Brown got 2 K's to start the 4th but was wild again, couldn't get the 3rd out and was removed with Hart still leading 8-4 with 2 on. Reliever Kyle Cook gave up a walk and a Grand Slam to tie it. Cook gave up 3 more singles, Valencia led 9-8. Tanner Sanchez relieved but could not stop the Vikings. Valencia kept it up until 11 had crossed the plate and led 14-8 when the inning ended.

In the game against Valencia on 5/6/2005, Hart was in a battle in a see-saw game. They were tied 4-4 going into the bottom of the 6th, but had missed big chances in every inning to blow the game open. Valencia had runners at 1st & 3rd in the 6th, 1 out, when a ground ball to short resulted in a rundown between home and 3rd. The runner was tagged out going back to 3rd (as declared by the home plate ump), but the base ump ruled otherwise. With the bases loaded, the next batter walked to force in the lead run. Before the 3rd out was made, 14 more runs scored as Hart used 4 pitchers in the inning. Donny Williams pitched to 1 batter and took the loss. He was followed by Steve Burton, Nick Streit and Jenzen Torres. There were 11 hits, 4 walks, a hit batter and an error. The big hit with Hart down 9-4 was a 3 run homer by Michael Hur off Nick Streit.

Hart struck back in the 7th with 2 homers by Shane Carlson and Tyler Fick, but the damage was done and Hart lost 19-6 in the Friday game.

The loss dropped Hart from 2nd to 4th in the Foothill League, but the following Tuesday Hart won a double header from Burbank (18-9 & 18-3) while Valencia was upset by Burroughs (10-3). Hart had re-gained 2nd place. Hart went to the playoffs as the 2nd place team and reached the Quarter Finals, before losing to Riverside Poly 4-3.

In the game against Alhambra on 5/15/92, Hart was sailing along with an 8-0 lead going into the bottom of the 6th. Alhambra then scored 9 runs to lead 9-8. Hart came back with 3 runs in the top of the 7th to win 11-9

In the game against Burbank on 4/21/98, Matt Friedrichsen hit a Grand Slam and a 3 run homer for 7 RBI's in the 11 run 3rd inning.

In the game against Burbank on 3/24/00, Hart scored 11 runs in the 1st, and then 11 more in the 2nd. Hart had 4 straight homers in the 1st. Mike Miller hit a 3 run HR, and Chris Gagnon, Matt Moore and Ryan Haag hit solo shots. In the 2nd inning, Marke Horvat hit a 3 run homer, and Bill Susdorf hit a Grand Slam. Hart pitchers (Tognetti & Burrows) NO Hit Burbank

In the game against Burbank on 4/28/00, Hart took a "very slim" 3-2 lead into the top of the 7th when they exploded for 11 runs. In the inning they hit 5 homers. Matt Friedrichsen & Ryan Haag hit solo shots. Brandon Montemayor & Chris Burrows hit 2 run homers & Matt Moore hit a 3 run homer. Moore's homer was his 2nd of the game
