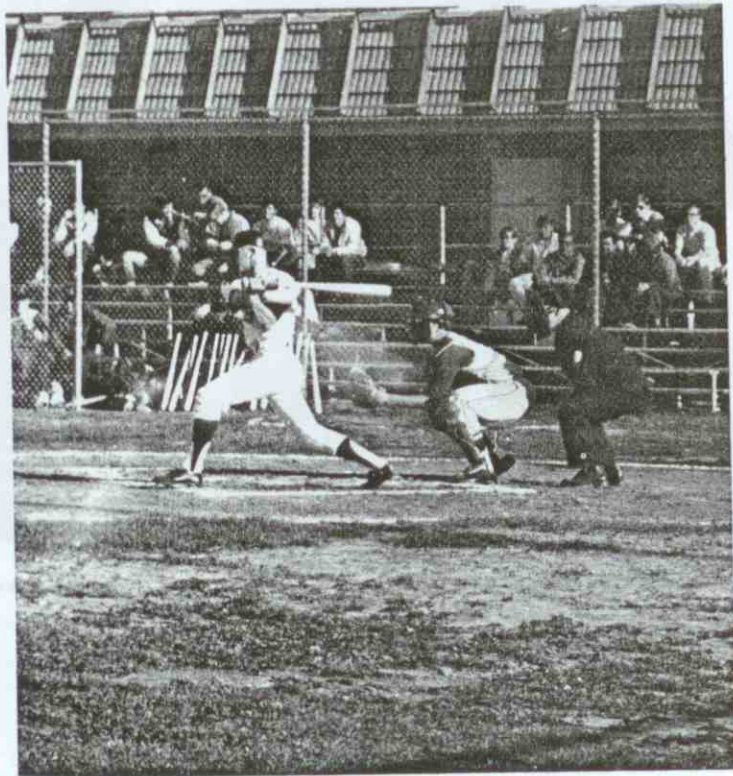


Our Diamonds In the Rough Pitch In

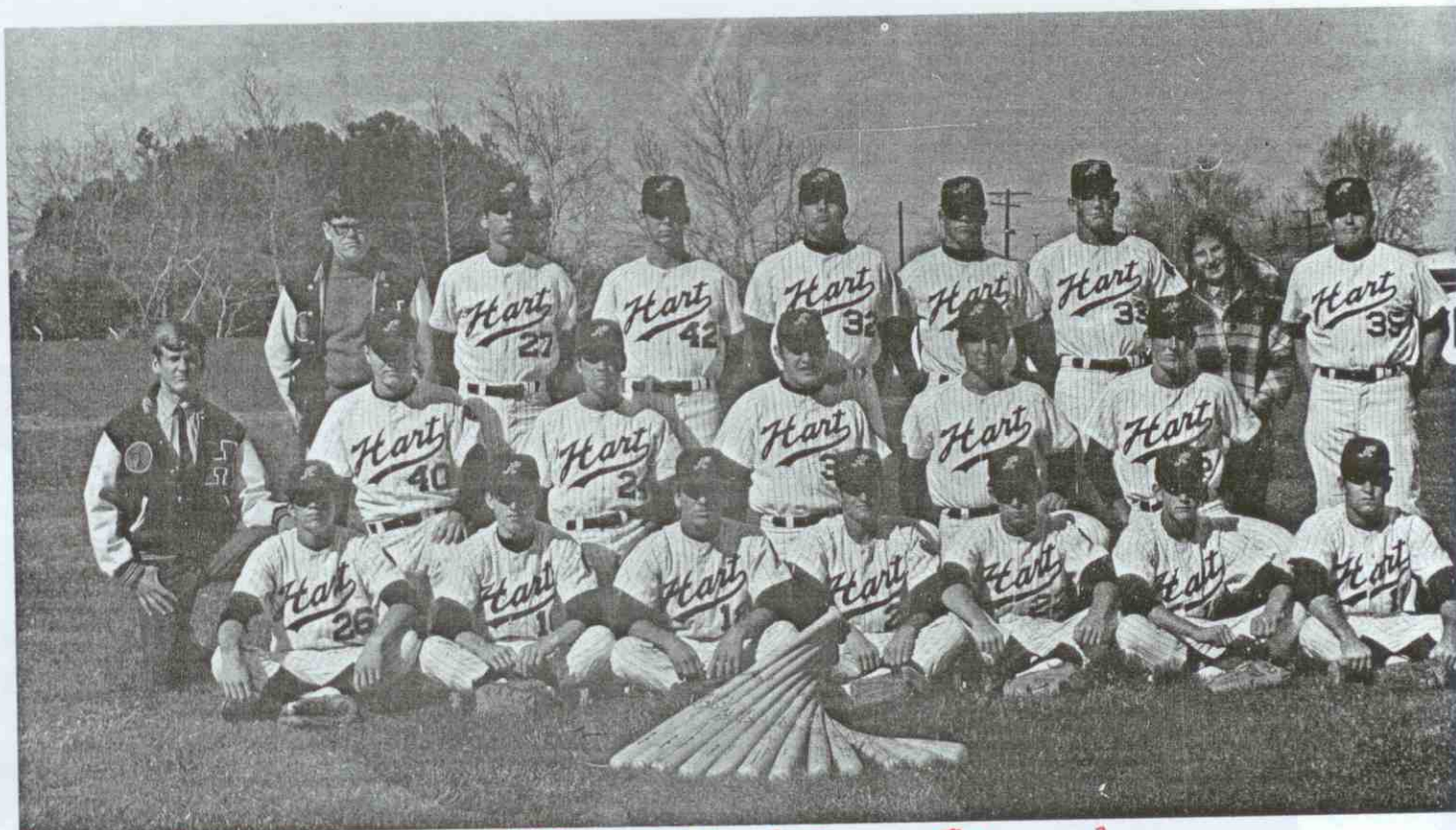
Edwards swings for the fence.
