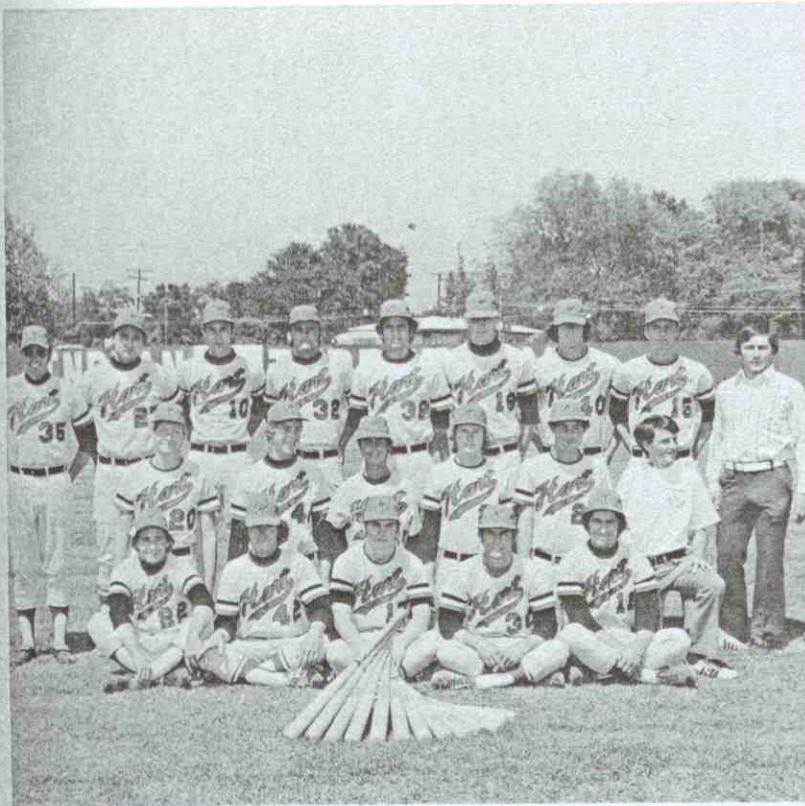

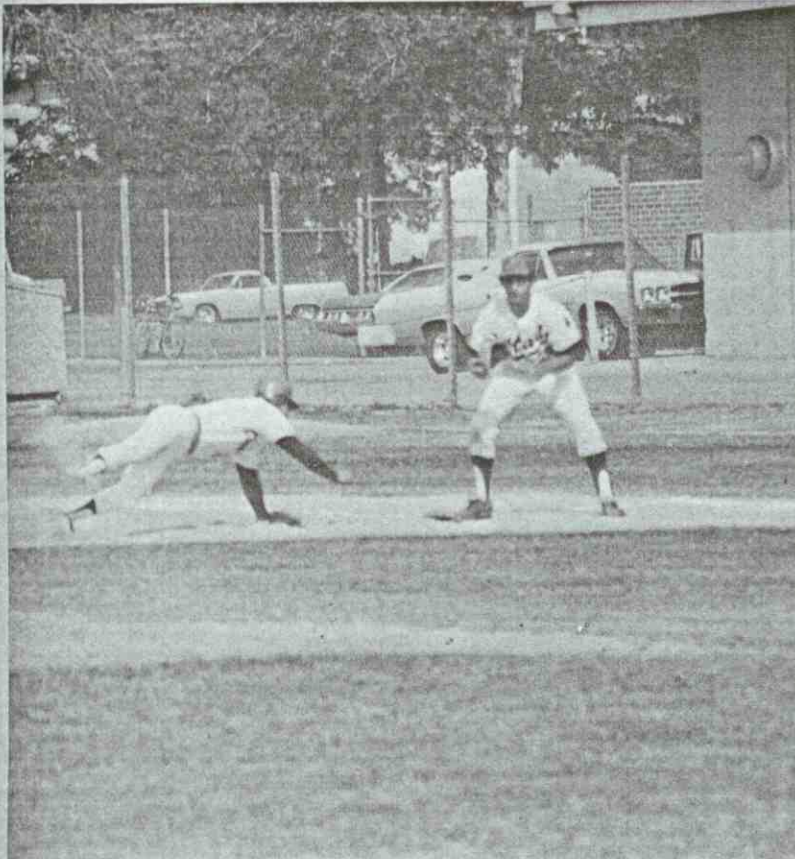


Putting their efforts together
