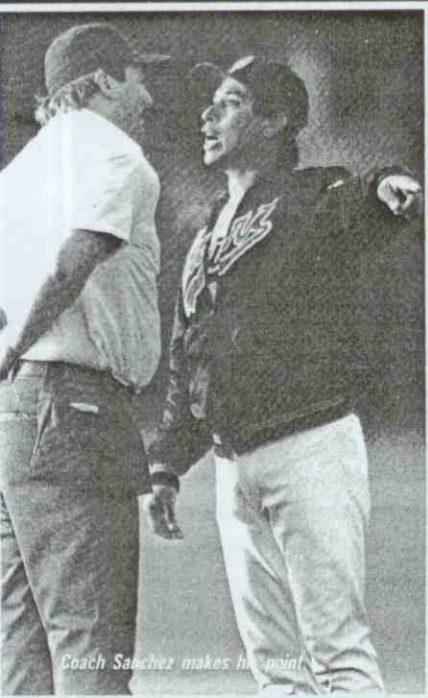




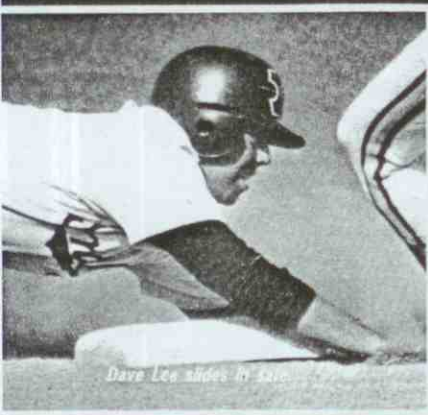
Raphy Loussarian makes the play to home plate.

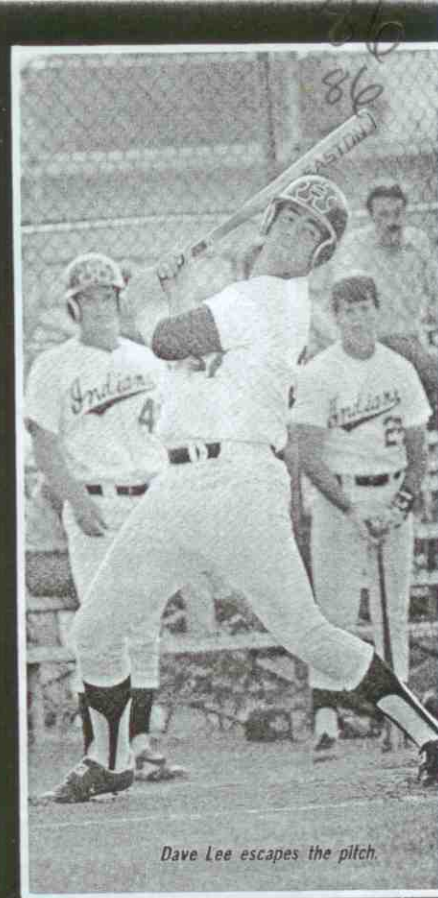

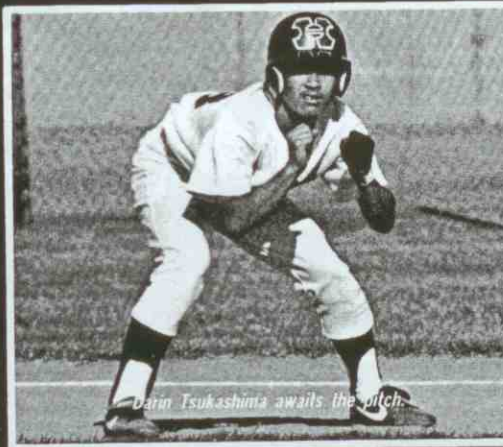

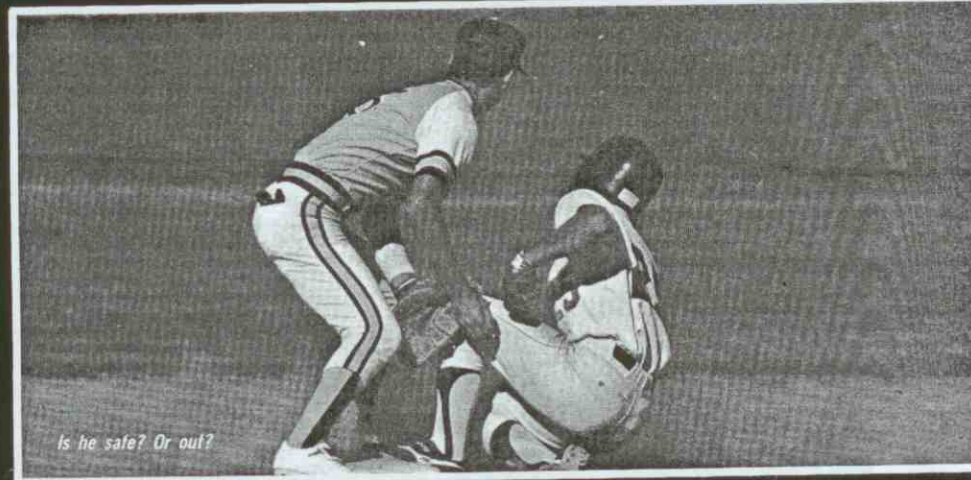
Mike Stephenson chucks the ball.



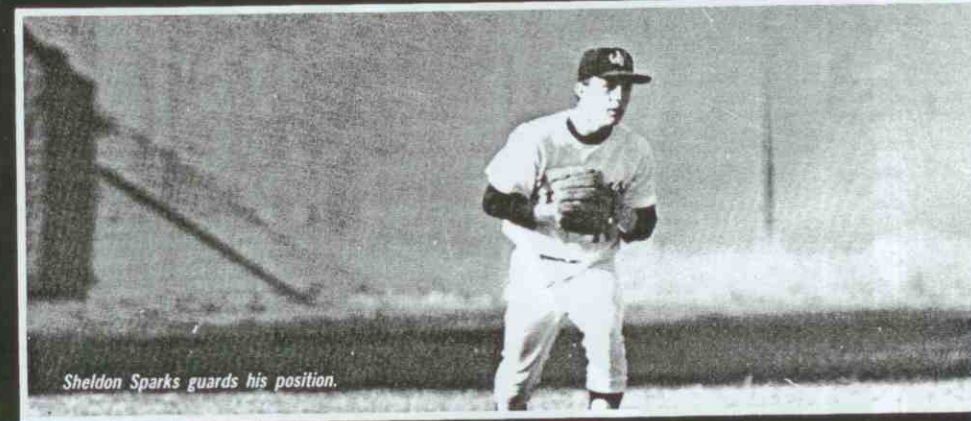
Dave Lee escapes the pitch.
