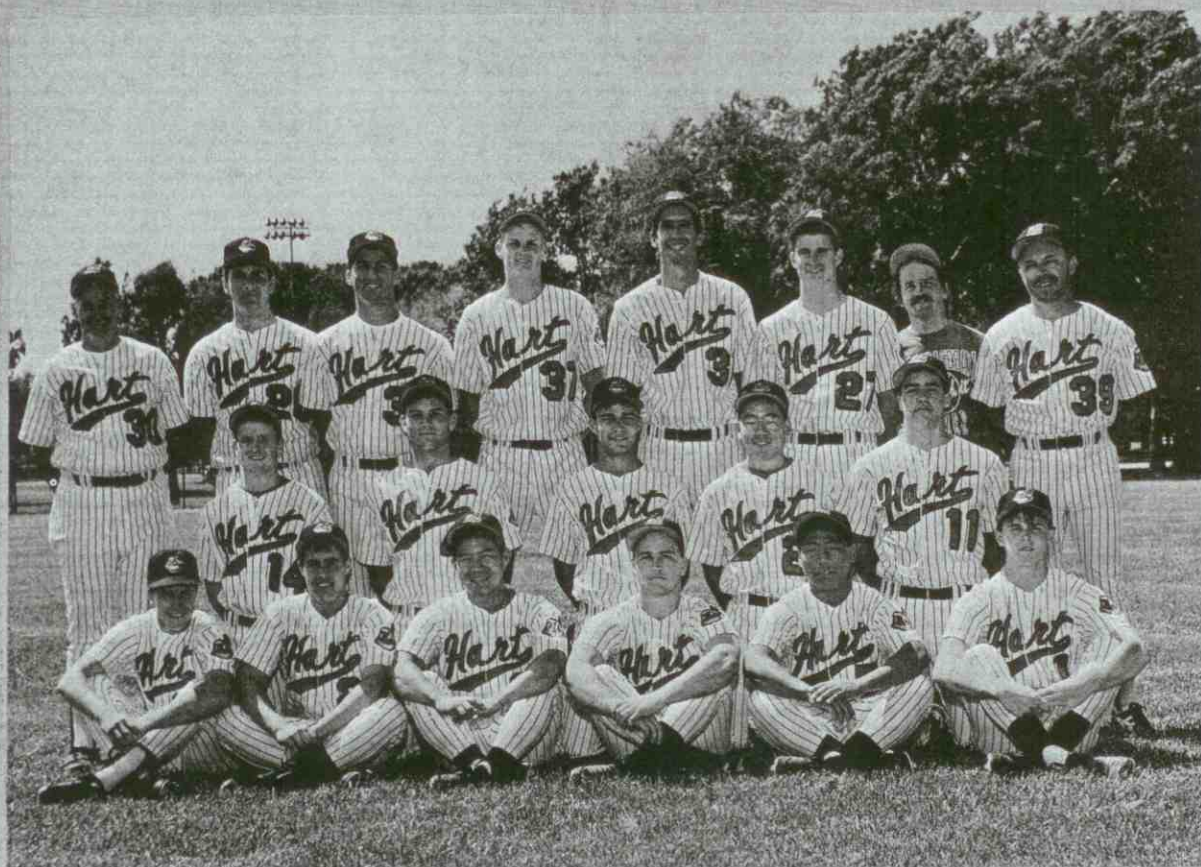

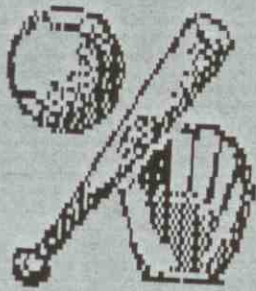

Rob Davis then stepped up to the plate and hit a grand-slam home run, which resulted in a victory of 5 to 1.

At the end of the regular season it was Hart's turn to travel to San Gabriel. While losing 5

to 1 in the fourth inning, Hart turned the tables and came back to beat San Gabriel 8 to 5.

In the first round of the playoffs, Hart met up with Clare-

mont. The Indians were down 3 to 1; however, Hart came back to win the game, 6 to 3.

Next they traveled to San Luis Obispo where the Indians unfortunately lost a hard fought game in the last inning 4 to 3. At the end of the game, Coach Bud Murray said, "Hart far exceeded what I expected."

Like many other players, Pitcher Andrew Lorraine had a superb season and received a baseball scholarship to Stanford. Along with Andrew, Rob Davis and Lance Migita also

had a fabulous year resulting in being voted as the leagues most valuable players. Chad Miyata, Doug Distaso, R.J. Simone and Keith Halcovich made First Team All-League. Tommy Wolff, who will be returning next year, had a very successful year behind the plate.

At the end of the year, the team was ranked first in the 4A CIF Division and seventeenth in the nation. Andrew Lorraine summed up the season by saying, "We had a great year.
