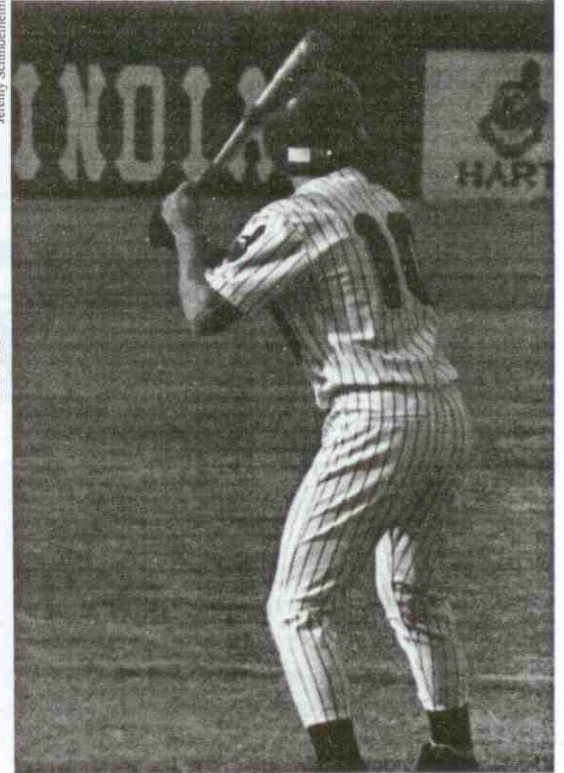

Batter **Casey Niccum** awaits his pitch. This junior player moved up from last year's J.V. team, to Varsity this year.

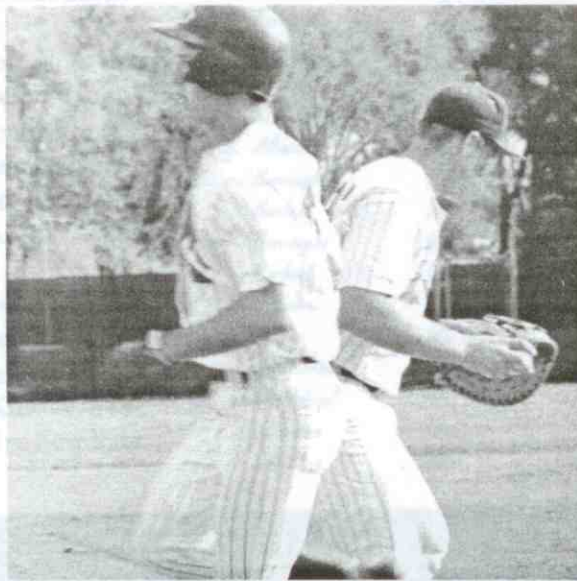

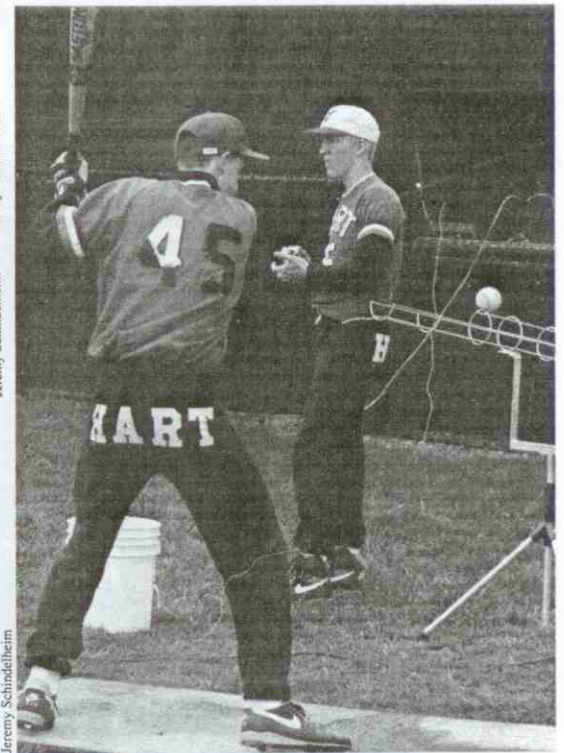

Sophomore **Mike Adachi** said, "Crowd encouragement makes me play better." Most players enjoy having parents and friends there the most.

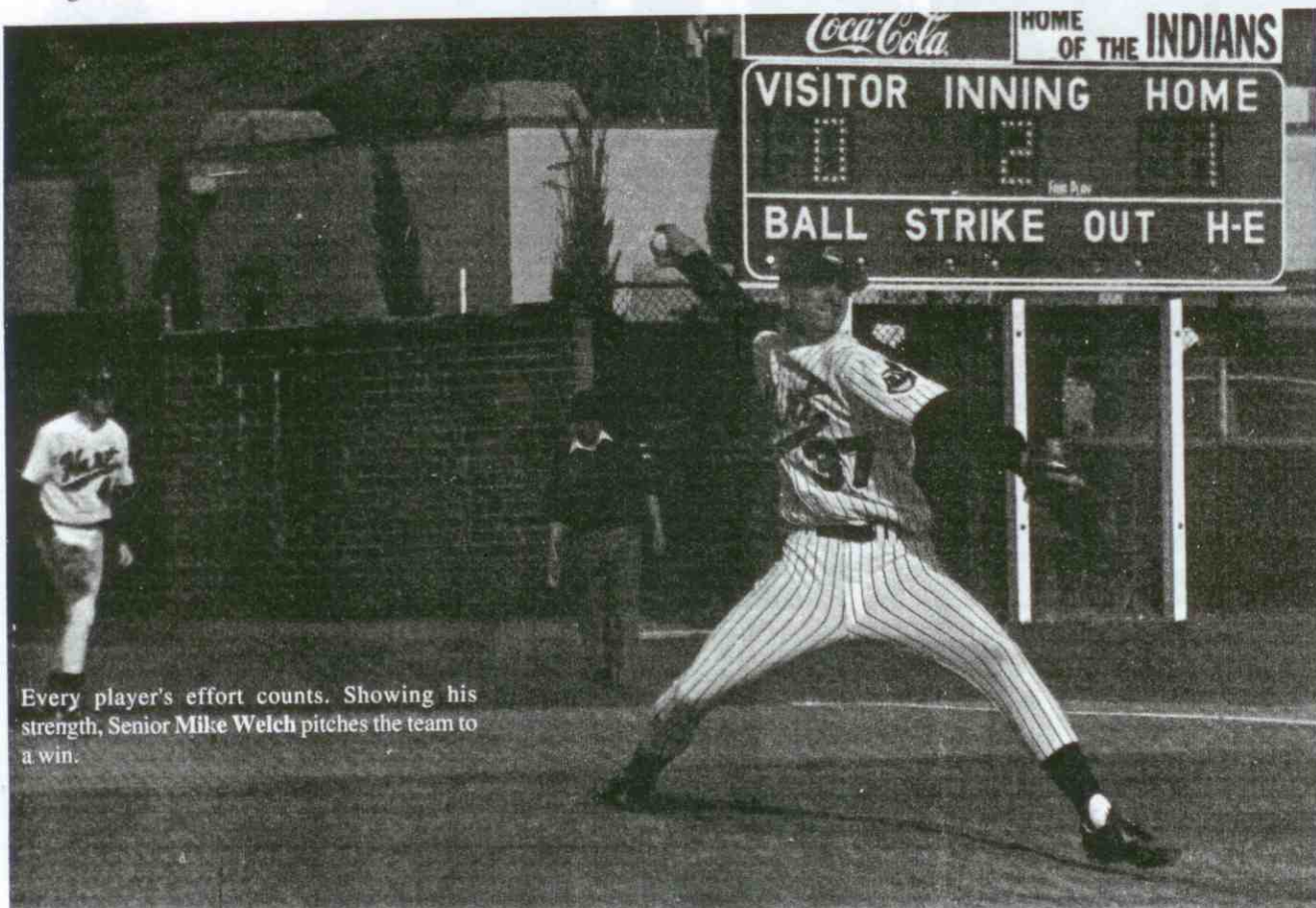
Depending on the player, crowd influence varies. For **Ted Kiester**, a senior, his mother "complains how long the game is."
